We pray for that day when a new dawn of justice will pierce the darkness of legalized abortion. May we never cease our efforts to proclaim to the world, **that all life is precious!**

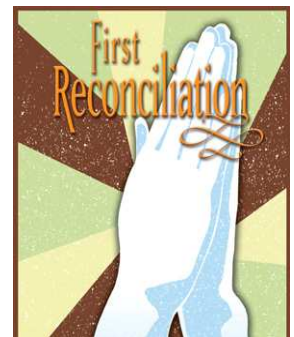
Lastly, we will also have breakfast available. The money raised will help offset the cost of sending our 5th and 6th grade students to Mohican. A free will donation will be taken at this event.
